

Q = Quail Feed. High-protein soybean meal is used in most poultry rations.

R = Renewable. Soybeans are a renewable resource. Fortunately, farmers can produce soybeans year after year, enabling this beneficial bean to continue its role in industry, medicine, agriculture and as a major food source for the world.

S = Soap. Can contain soybean oil.

T = Textured Protein. Textured proteins and protein concentrates extracted from soybean meal extend and improve many processed meat products. Adding soy protein to processed meats can reduce the fat content, cholesterol content and cost, while retaining the product's flavor. Examples of foods containing textured protein: pizza, tacos, TV dinners, spaghetti and meatballs, chili, etc.

U = Unsaturated Fat. Most of the oil labeled "vegetable oil" is soybean oil. Soybean oil is low in saturated fat, contains no cholesterol and has a neutral flavor.

V = Varnish. Soybean oil makes an excellent base for varnishes, paints and other coating materials.

W = Wax. Soy wax for candles provides a longer-lasting, clean-burning alternative to petroleum-based paraffin wax.

X = X-Ray Film. Soybean ingredients are used in x-ray films as well as in video tapes.

Y = Yogurt. Many products, similar to dairy products, have been developed using soy protein. These include yogurt, soy beverages, non-dairy frozen desserts, soy cheese and others.

Z = Zebra Feed. High-protein soybean meal is used to feed a variety of animals found in zoos.
